

## GREENLAND & FAROE ISLANDS

Please use this checklist if you are <u>only</u> applying for a visa for Greenland and/or the Faroe Islands. If you are also applying for a Schengen visa, please see the <u>relevant checklist</u> for a Schengen visa.

If any documents are marked with <u>NO</u> below, your application for a visa for only Greenland and/or the Faroe Islands is *incomplete*. Please arrange with VFS to hand in the missing documents <u>within 5 calendar</u> <u>days from today</u>. If the documents have not been received by this deadline, the decision will be based on the information available.

You will be informed when a decision on your visa application has been reached or if further information is needed. *Missing documents, declining to provide further documentation or not making yourself available for interview when asked may negatively affect the visa decision.* 

Required documents provided when handing in application:	YES	NO
<b>Correctly signed application form</b> — Printed and signed ApplyVisa cover letter. Signature must match the one in your passport		
<b>Signed current passport</b> (+ colour copy of all pages) – issued within the last 10 years, have two blank pages and be valid for at least 3 months beyond your intended stay		
<b>Proof of UK residency</b> (e.g. Immigration Share Code) – residency must be valid for 1 month beyond your intended stay in the Schengen area.		
Proof of sufficient funds for the stay – original bank statements showing the balance and your full name and address, covering the last 3 calendar months – approx. DKK 350-500 per day  - If sponsored by spouse: Marriage certificate + sponsor letter + spouse's bank statements  - Minors sponsored by a parent: Birth certificate + sponsor letter + parent's bank statements		
Proof of purpose of stay (+ dates of intended stay) – e.g. flight/ferry/hotel/cruise reservations, itinerary or invitation from host in Greenland/Faroe Islands. Invitations must be dated, signed, explain the purpose of stay and contain the host's contact details  - If your flight/ferry/cruise reservations show transit in the Schengen area, you must also provide copy of your valid Schengen visa (alternatively, provide explanation on how you will obtain a Schengen visa valid for the given period)  - We recommend that you do not buy any tickets before your visa has been approved		
Minors (under 18 years) – the following documents must also be provided:		
Original birth certificate for the minor with both parents' names  - If one parent has sole custody or guardianship of the minor: Birth certificate mentioning one parent <u>OR</u> Death certificate of absent parent <u>OR</u> Court ruling		
Original passport of both parents (or ID cards with signature) + residence permit, if applicable		
Written consent for issuance of visa from both parents/guardian(s): Please be aware of the following rules in the UK: Get permission to take a child abroad - GOV.UK
